## What's in it for you?

Return your containers promptly to keep the cycle efficient and cost-effective.

## What you need to know.

Federal and Provincial regulations govern the handling of hazardous waste—including residues left in containers. If a returned IBC, drum, or carboy contains residue above the permissible limit, your organization may be classified as a hazardous waste generator and subject to additional handling fees under environmental legislation. Empty container of all residue.

To comply with the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Act and Regulations, all empty containers must be securely sealed with original bungs, caps, and lids, and retain their original labels.

Container Return Standards



## ClearTech container return standards

To qualify for return, containers must meet the following criteria:

- Be a ClearTech returnable container.
- Have legible original labels, markings, and classifications.
- Be completely empty and free of all residue, both inside and out.
- Be *securely closed* with the appropriate fill caps, bungs, lids, gaskets, and valves.
- Be suitable for reuse, with no punctures, cuts, cracks, paint, stains, or markings.
- Be *returned ideally within 3 months* of receipt.
- Be returned within the following timeframes to avoid forfeiture of the deposit:
  - > Intermediate Bulk Containers (IBCs) within 120 days of shipment.
  - > All other returnable containers within 1 year of shipment.

Additionally, pallets must:

Be in good condition, with no broken or missing slats.

These containers <u>cannot</u> be accepted for return





Residue exceeds 3.5 L in IBCs,
1 inch in drums, and ½ inch in carboys, or residue
other than original contents

These containers <u>will be accepted for return</u>, but <u>deposit cannot be refunded</u>



Hole or gash in head, bottom, or body



These containers will be accepted for return, but deposit may be partially refunded
